What you can expect from UCW

- **We will** deliver high-quality teaching and effective management of your learning, and our education provision will be subjected to independent review and inspection.
- **We will** provide appropriate and flexible learning resources and facilities that are fit for purpose.
- **We will** appoint an academic member of staff to act as your personal tutor, and you will have a minimum of three one-to-one tutorials with them every year that you are enrolled at UCW.
- **We will** give you access to a virtual learning environment and your programme handbook, which will include up-to-date and accurate information about your course and assessments.



- **We will** publish an accurate timetable prior to your course starting and give you fair notice before making any changes to either your timetable or course.
- **We will** conduct assessments with due regard for the QAA Quality Code, and ensure you receive timely feedback that is constructive and enhances your learning.
- **We will** encourage you to feed back on the quality of your programme and comment on your overall experience at UCW, and then communicate any outcomes with you.
- **We will** organise a range of sporting, social, cultural and extra-curricular activities throughout the year for all students who wish to take part.
- **We will** make available a Careers Coaching Service dedicated to Higher Education students to help you explore your post-university options and plot your path through the world of work.



What UCW expects from you

- **To** take responsibility for your own learning.
- **To** actively engage with your course by attending and participating in all taught sessions, completing the work assigned to you and carrying out any related work placements.
- **To** submit work for assessment within the published deadlines.
- **To** respect the physical environment, staff members, fellow students and our neighbours.
- **To** share your ideas and comments about your programme and overall experience with us by providing feedback through induction questionnaires, module evaluations and the National Student Survey, or by becoming a Student Representative and attending Staff Student Liaising Committees and Student Forums.
- **To** familiarise yourself with the Weston College Group's regulations, policies and procedures and comply with these at all times.
- **To** make prompt payment of any charges made by UCW.
