

# APPLICATION PROCESS CHECKLIST FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

**Create UCAS account and apply to our programme at UCW**

**Get your supporting documents together!**

This is a vital step. Your supporting documents will need to include:

- A copy of a valid passport
- A copy of your current highest qualification
- A NARIC/ENIC official statement of comparison for your international qualifications.
- An IELTS score of 6.0
- Confirmation of how you intend to fund the course and that you have read and understood the Tuition Fees Policy.

**Start looking into the visa application process.**

**Some of these steps can take a while to achieve if you don't already possess the appropriate certification, so please begin working on collecting all the above documentation at the beginning of your application process.**

All the above steps will be requested at your audition, as we won't be able to consider your application fully until we've received your UCAS application and supporting documentation.
